

# Sea Freight from China to San Pedro Sula

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□ Sea Freight

China → San Pedro Sula · via SAP air / Puerto Cortes sea · clearance by Administración Aduanera de Honduras

Freight from China into San Pedro Sula clears through SAP air / Puerto Cortes sea. San Pedro Sula is the industrial capital and main distribution base, and the inland leg is same-day, so the clearance date is effectively the delivery date.

On the destination side, Administración Aduanera de Honduras handles clearance; budget 4–10 days of dwell before the cargo is released.

## Import duty and tax position for San Pedro Sula

Imports into Honduras are cleared by Administración Aduanera de Honduras. The headline position is: ISV 15%; Central American common tariff 0–15%. The de-minimis threshold is USD 100 for courier consignments.

Conformity is the part most first-time importers underestimate: Health registration for food and cosmetics; conformity for regulated goods. Getting this wrong is expensive because it usually cannot be fixed after the cargo has landed.

**Restrictions and known friction points for Honduras:** Transshipment dependency means feeder timing drives the schedule. Free-zone regimes for the apparel sector have separate duty treatment.

## How this lane actually runs

Puerto Cortés is the deepest and best-equipped port in Central America and clears a large share of the region's Atlantic-side volume. San Pedro Sula is the commercial center and the natural distribution base, with Tegucigalpa served by road. Asian cargo normally transships at Panama, Cartagena or Kingston.

## What to sort out before the cargo leaves China

- Photograph carton markings and seal numbers before departure — it makes any claim far easier to settle.
- Put the San Pedro Sula delivery address, contact name and phone number on the invoice, not just the packing list.
- Check the de-minimis position (USD 100 for courier consignments) against your invoice value before you decide how to split the shipment.
- Book earlier than the transit time suggests during Sep–Nov, when space on this lane tightens.
- Plan around the China-side windows too: Chinese New Year and Golden Week both compress capacity on the Honduras lane.
- Use ISPM-15 treated pallets. Untreated wood is the most common reason otherwise-clean cargo gets held.

## Frequently asked questions

How long does shipping from China to San Pedro Sula take?

China to the Honduras gateway is 26–34 calendar days. On top of that, allow 4–10 days of clearance with Administración Aduanera de Honduras and a same-day inland leg to San Pedro Sula.

What duty and tax will I pay importing into San Pedro Sula?

Administración Aduanera de Honduras applies: ISV 15%; Central American common tariff 0–15%. The de-minimis position is USD 100 for courier consignments. Under a DDP arrangement these are pre-paid, so nothing is collected on arrival in San Pedro Sula.

Which port or airport does cargo for San Pedro Sula clear through?

Cargo for San Pedro Sula is routed via SAP air / Puerto Cortes sea. Sea gateways for Honduras are Puerto Cortés, Henecán (San Lorenzo); air gateways are SAP (San Pedro Sula), TGU (Tegucigalpa). We pick whichever gives the shortest total door time for your address.

Can you ship batteries or sensitive cargo to San Pedro Sula?

Yes. Battery cargo by sea moves under UN3480/UN3481 with an MSDS, and the dangerous-goods documentation is prepared as part of the booking into Puerto Cortés, Henecán (San Lorenzo). Surcharges apply and space is more limited than for general cargo.

Can you deliver door-to-door in San Pedro Sula?

Yes. Delivery to a San Pedro Sula address is quoted as one figure covering freight, duty and tax owed to Administración Aduanera de Honduras, and the same-day inland leg. Confirm whether your consignee wants the goods at a warehouse, a marketplace fulfillment center or a shop front, because the last-mile requirement differs.

When is the busiest time on the China–Honduras lane?

Space and rates tighten around Sep–Nov, plus the China-side windows of Chinese New Year in January or February and Golden Week in early October. Book one to two weeks earlier in those periods.

## Checking the Honduras duty position yourself

Duty and tax figures on this page are planning estimates. The binding assessment is made by Administración Aduanera de Honduras against your declared HS code at the time of entry; where the amount is material, verify the current rate through [ITC Market Access Map](#) before committing to an order.

If you want to sanity-check a duty figure yourself, start from the heading rather than the product name — [the WCO Harmonized System](#) is the underlying nomenclature, and [the WTO Tariff & Trade Data portal](#) holds the applied rates by country pair.

For ocean cargo, restricted commodities move under [the IMO's IMDG Code](#), and the container has to be declared and stowed accordingly. Batteries, flammables and corrosives all have a compliant ocean path; what causes rolled bookings is finding out about them after the container is packed.

On the origin side, export declaration and any commodity inspection requirement fall under [China Customs \(GACC\)](#); we handle that filing as part of the service, but the requirement is theirs, not ours.
